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

## **MOST REPSECTFULLY SHEWETH:**

1. That the appellants interalia challenge the order dtd.12.01.2024 in W.P.(C) No. 762 of 2023 wherein the Hon'ble Single Judge quashed the office order

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dtd. 30.12.2022 with a further direction to extend the benefit of pay protection as due and admissible in favour of the respondent in terms of Annexure-8 & 9 on the ground the said order is complete erroneous and contrary to the materials on record. The factual back drop of the case is more fully stated hereunder.

2. That the respondent No.1 was appointed as a training associate, plant protection (subsequently redesignated as SMS/Scientist) as per office order No.17750/ UAT dtd.16.6.2006 of the Registrar contractual basis and he joined the post on 23.6.2006 in Krushi Vigyan Kendra, Boudh in the scale of pay of Rs.8000 - Rs.13,500/- which was subsequently revised to Rs.15,600/- to Rs.39,100/- with AGP Rs.6000/-. While continuing as such the post of Training Associate re-designated as Subject Matter Specialist. It was also case of the respondent No.1 while continuing on contractual basis another advertisement was issued on 18.11.2024 by the University for recruitment to the post of Asst. Professor and in its equivalent cadre on regular basis. The respondent No.1 in response to said advertisement applied for the post and was selected in the process of recruitment. After being duly selected he was issued with an appointment order on 31.12.2015 and

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on being relieved from the post of Scientist (Plant Protection) he joined on 13.1.2016.

- 3. That, it was also further case of the respondent No.1/petitioner the Board of management OUAT had taken decision resolution No.3942 in its dtd.02.09.2015 to allow pay protection to its employees who have been continuing as subject matter specialist/programme coordinator in KVKS under OUAT on appointment and joining as Asst. Professor or in equivalent post in constituent colleges and research Unit under OUAT. Pursuant to such decision the University issued a notification allowing pay protection to the Subject Matter Specialist and in equivalent post or joining as Assistant Professor on its equivalent post.
- 4. That, it was also further case of the respondent No.1 though he was holding the post of Subject Matter Specialist and subsequently posted as Jr. Pathologist which is equivalent to Assistant professor, he is entitled to the benefit flowing from the notification dtd.26.09.2015. Though this Hon'ble Court vide order dtd.17.11.2021 in W.P.(C) No.34221 of 2021 filed by respondent No.1 direction was issued to consider the representation but the same was rejected without assigning the reasons as per his grievance. When similarly situated persons have been granted pay

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protection, rejection of his representation not in accordance with the resolution and notification under Annexure - 8 & 9 of the writ petition and more over the provisions of Rule -50(1) and Rule -51 of the OUAT Statute,1966. Accordingly the respondent No.1 in his writ petition has sought for the following reliefs:

"Under the above circumstances, it is therefore humbly prayed that the Hon'ble Court be graciously pleased to quash the order dtd.30.12.2022 of the Opposite Party No.2 under Annexure-15 and direct the Opposite Parties No. 2 & 3 to grant the benefit of pay protection to the petitioner of his earlier post on joining the regular post as per the resolution of the Board of Management dtd.02.09.2015 and the consequential notification dtd.26.09.2015 under Annexure-8 and 9 respectively read with Rule-50(1) and 51 of the OUAT Statute, 1966, within a stipulated period as deem fit and proper;

And further the Hon'ble Court be pleased to direct the Opposite Party No. 2 and 3 to calculate the differential arrears of such pay revision of the petitioner on granting pay protection and pay the same to him within a stipulated period as deem fit and proper."

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A copy of the writ petition is filed herewith as **ANNEXRUE-1.** 

5. That, the appellants filed their counter stating interalia that the petitioner was initially appointed as Training Associate, Plant Protection at KVK, Boudh as per advertisement issued vide No.19396/UAT, dtd. 16.07.2004 (Annex-1) and appointment order issued vide office order No.17750/UAT, dt.16.06.2006 (Annex-2). As per the said appointment order, he joined on 23.06.2006 (F.N) on contractual basis with certain terms and Conditions in the scale of pay of Rs.8,000-275-13,500/- with usual DA & other allowances as admissible from time to time. As per SL.No.6 of the said appointment order, it has been clearly mentioned that "the past services if any (regular/temporary) shall not be counted and there shall be no continuity of the past services. So also the service during contractual period shall not be counted in the regular service". While the petitioner was continuing in KVK Kendrapara, he was selected for the post of Junior Pathologist (Asst. Professor equivalent) through proper selection procedure. The OUAT is administrative authority for both the post of Training Associate (re-designated as SMS/Scientist) under KVK and also the post of Junior Pathologist (Asst.Professor/Equivalent) under regular

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establishment of OUAT. But the KVK employees under OUAT are the contractual project staff till 100% funding of ICAR continues. The Service condition of KVK employees have been notified vide OUAT Notification No.19832/UAT, dt. 27.08.2014 after receipt of instruction from Govt. of Odisha vide letter No. 12043/Ag, dt. 18.07.2014 which is binding to all KVK employees under OUAT. According to the said notification the service conditions of contractual staff in KVKs under OUAT are as follows:

- 1. The KVK employees are contractual staff and allowed regular scale of pay with annual increments and other benefits as per the CAR guidelines till 100% funding of ICAR continues.
- 2. The KVK employees are not entitled to terminal benefits and their service is coterminous with the central project i.e. till the period 100% funds are made available by ICAR.
- The State Government and OUAT will not shoulder any kind of liability pertaining to KVKs.
- 4. The transfer of KVK employees will be within the KVKs only

It is a fact that after receipt of representation from some of the SMSs and Programme Coordinators in REGISTRAR Odisha University of Agril & Technology

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the KVKs for protection of pay in their new appointment in the regular of post Asst. Professor/equivalent Associate or Professor/equivalent as the case may be, their cases were placed before the Board of Management through the memorandum. After approval of the BOM vide Resolution No.3942 dt.02.09.2015, a notification was issued vide No.21880/UAT, dt. 26.09.2015 to allow the protection of pay of the SMS/ Programme Coordinator of KVKs who are to be appointed as Asst. Professor/equivalent and Associate Professor/ equivalent respectively in the regular post under OUAT. The petitioner while working as SMS in KVK prior to his joining as Junior Pathologist on 13.01.2016 in the regular establishment under OUAT, his scale of pay was Rs. 15,600-39,100/GP-6,000/-(pre-revised scale). Accordingly, he was drawing the pay of Rs.22,220/ as basic pay and GP-Rs.6,000/- as on 12.01.2016 i.e. on the date of relief from KVK to join in the regular post under OUAT. Since the post of Junior Pathologist was Carrying the scale of pay of Rs.15,600-39,100 + AGP Rs.6,000/- the petitionerwas appointed in the above scale of pay and accordingly his pay was fixed at Rs.15,600 + AGP Rs.6,000/- on dt.13.01.2016 i.e. the date of his joining

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in the post of Junior Pathologist. In the counter it was further clarified that 13 persons as per Annex-12 of writ petition were appointed as regular employees of OUAT. Subsequently, they were selected and appointed as contractual employees under KVKs. They were again re-absorbed to regular posts vide court orders and approval of the Board of Management, OUAT. The case of the petitioner is not similar with that of the 13 employees referred under Annexure-12. No similar employee like the petitioner has ever been given the protection of pay being absorbed into a regular post.

A copy of the counter is filed herewith as ANNEXURE-2.

6. That, the respondent No.1 filed a rejoinder stating interalia chapter-2 of Article-4 of the OUAT statute, 1989 provides the benefits of pay protection to the initial appointees in the OUAT subject to the condition the employee concerned are working in State Govt. or Central Govt. or any College affiliated to any University or an aided Institution or statutory institutions immediately before joining the University. As he was working in Krushi Vigyan Kendra as per Article-4 of Chapter-2 of OUAT Statute, he is entitled to the benefit of pay protection on joining in the

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OUAT cadre as a Jr. Pathology. A copy of the rejoinder is filed herewith as ANNEXURE-3.

- 7. That, the matter was taken up on 12.01.2024 and the Hon'ble Court after hearing the parties disposed of the writ petition by quashing the office order dtd.30.12.2022 under Annexure-15 to the writ petition with a further direction to extend the benefit of pay protection as due and admissible in favour of him in terms of Annexure-8 & 9. The said order is complete erroneous, non-application of mind and liable to be set aside. A copy of the order dtd.12.01.2024 is filed herewith as ANNEXURE-4.
- **8.** That, the appellants seek to challenge the order dtd.12.01.2024 on the following amongst other grounds:

**GROUNDS** 

- A. For that the Hon'ble Single Judge, while deciding the matter has not taken into account the materials on record and decided the matter in an erroneous manner. Hence the same is liable to be quashed.
- B. For that the specific stand of the appellants is that the Service condition of KVK employees has been notified vide OUAT Notification No.19832/UAT, dt. 27.08.2014 after receipt of

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instruction from Govt. of Odisha No12043/Ag, dt. 18.07.2014 which is binding KVK employees under OUAT. According to the said notification the KVK employees are contractual staff and allowed regular scale of pay with annual increments and other benefits as per the ICAR guidelines till 100% funding of ICAR continues. They are not entitled to terminal benefits and their service is coterminous with the central project i.e. till the period 100% funds are made available by ICAR. The State Government and OUAT will not shoulder any kind of liability pertaining to KVKs. The Hon'ble single judge while deciding the writ petitions has not been taken into account the said aspect. Hence the same is liable to be quashed.

C. For that, in the counter affidavit the specific stand of appellants is that thirteen (13) nos. of employees (Annexure-12 of the writ petition) are not similar to respondent no-1 but the Hon'ble single judge while deciding the writ petitions has not been taken into account the said aspect. Hence the same is liable to be quashed.

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- D. For that, though the respondent No. 1 was not covered under Statute 50 & 51 of OUAT statute which is applicable only to regular employees but the said aspect has not been taken into account while deciding the writ petitions. Hence the same is liable to be quashed.
- E. For that though it is the specific case of the appellants the respondent No.1 is not covered by resolution under Annexure-8 and notification under Annexure-9, but the Hon'ble Single Judge, erroneously directed to extend the said benefit to respondent No.1 in terms of the said resolution. Hence the same is liable to be quashed.
- F. For that, the respondent No.1 has never objected to the terms and conditions of his appointment order, after accepting the terms and conditions of his appointment he cannot turn around for protection of pay at a later stage. Hence the order passed by the Hon'ble Court being erroneous, the same is liable to be quashed.
- 9. That the Appellants have no speedy and efficacious remedy than to invoke the extraordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.

order no. 21309 dtd: 30.12.2022 of the Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology (OUAT) under Annexure-15 and further prayed for a direction to the Opposite Parties No. 2 and 3 to allow him the pay protection as per the decision of the Board of Management in its resolution no. 3942 dtd: 02.09.2015 under Annexure-8 and consequential administrative notification no.21880/UAT dtd: 26.09.2015 under Annexure-9 read with Rule-50 and 51 of the OUAT Statute, 1966 with all consequential service and financial benefits including differential arrears.

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- 2. That the petitioner is a citizen of India and a permanent resident of the state of Odisha. The cause of action for filing this case arises within the territorial jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.
- That the Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology 3. (OUAT) has issued an advertisement on 16.07.2004 to fill up the post of Training Associate. The petitioner having the eligibility for the post was duly selected and appointed as a Training Associate (Plant Protection) in office order no. 17750/UAT dtd: 16.06.2006 of the Registrar and he joined the post on 23.06.2006 (F/N) in Kursi Vigyan Kendra, Boudh in the scale of pay of Rs. 8000-275-13, 500/-, (prerevised), which has been subsequently revised to Rs. 15600/- to 39100/- with the AGP Rs. 6000/-. While continuing as such the post of training associate was re-designated as Subject Matter Specialist in letter dtd: 05.06.2006 of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi. For better appreciation of the case the copy of the advertisement dtd: 16.07.2004, the appointment order dtd: 16.06.2006 and the letter dtd: 05.06.2006 of the ICAR, New Delhi are annexed herewith as Annexure-1, 2 and 3 respectively.
- 4. That while the petitioner was continuing as a Scientist (Plant TRUE COPY ATTESTED Protection) on Contractual basis, on regular scale of pay, another

advertisement was issued on 18.11.2014 by the University for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and in its equivalent cadre on regular basis. The petitioner having the eligibility for the post of Asst. Professor in Plant Pathology had applied as per advertisement dtd: 18.11.2014 and was also duly selected in the process of recruitment and issued with an appointment order in office order no. 29858/UAT dtd: 31.12.2015 of the Vice Chancellor, OUAT. Pursuant to such order he was relieved from the post of Scientist (Plant Protection) on 12.01.2016 (AN) in order to enable him to join as Junior Pathologist, AICRP on Jute Research Station, Kendrapara under OUAT, Bhubaneswar and he joined on 13.01.2016 (FN). For better appreciation of the case the copies of the Advertisement dtd: 18.11.2014, the appointment order dtd: 31.12.2015, the relieve order dtd: 12.01.2016 and the relevant extract of the service book of the petitioner disclosing of his joining as Junior Pathologist on 13.01.2016 are annexed herewith as Annexure-4, 5, 6 and 7 respectively.

5. That it is not out of place to mention here that the petitioner
was continuing in OUAT and having been selected in the next
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advertisement he was also appointed by the same authority in the

same university. Many such persons have also been appointed in the same nature of post to which the petitioner has now been appointed and therefore this is a common phenomenon. Accordingly the Board of Management, OUAT has taken a decision in its resolution No. 3942 dtd: 02.09.2015 to allow pay protection to its employees who have been continuing as Subject Matter Specialist/Programme Coordinator in KVKs under OUAT on appointment and joining as Assistant Professor or in equivalent posts in the Constituent Colleges and Research Units under OUAT. Pursuant to such decision, the Vice Chancellor of the University has issued a notification bearing no. 21880 dtd: 26.09.2015 allowing pay protection to the Subject Matter Specialist and in equivalent posts on joining as Assistant Professor or its equivalent posts. For better appreciation of the case the copy of the resolution of the Board of Management, OUAT dtd: 02.09.2015 and the consequential notification dtd: 26.09.2015 are annexed herewith as Annexure-8 and 9 respectively.

6. That it is respectfully submitted that since the petitioner was also holding the post of Subject Matter Specialist and subsequently posted as Junior Pathologist which is equivalent to Asst. Professor, he TRUE COPY ATTESTED

is entitled to the benefit flowing from the notification under

Odisha University of Agril & Technology

Annexure-9. It is needles to mention here that when the petitioner was relieved from the post of Subject Matter Specialist he was in the scale of pay of Rs. 15600/- to 39100/- with AGP of Rs. 6000/- in the PB-1 and his last pay drawn was Rs. 22220/- with AGP Rs. 6000/-. Therefore, pursuant to the notification dtd: 26.09.2015, he is get the benefit of pay protection in joining as Junior Pathologist which is also carry the scale of pay of Rs. 15600/- to 39,100/- with AGP of Rs. 6000/- as it evident from Annexure-5. However on joining as Junior Pathologist the pay of the petitioner was paid at the initial of the basic pay instead of the pay protection available to him under the notification dtd: 26.09.2015. For better appreciation of the case the last pay drawn by the petitioner as a Subject Matter Specialist and the initial pay in the post of Junior Pathologist as it evident from the relevant extract of the service book of the petitioner are annexed herewith as Annexure-10 and 11 respectively.

7. That it is respectively submitted that not allowing the pay protection to the petitioner in the post of Junior Pathologist under Annexure-11 by the OUAT is nothing but violation of its own notification dtd: 26.09.2015 and the Board of Management

Resolution dtd: 02.09.2015 under Annexure-8. However the same

authorities have allowed the identical relief of pay protection to as many as 13 persons in office order no. 22880 dtd: 08.10.2015. Even the contractual employees have also been granted the pay protection prior to such decision/notification of OUAT as it evident from letter no. 16272 dtd: 28.04.2005. For better appreciation of the case the copy of the order dtd: 08.10.2015 and dtd: 28.04.2005 are annexed herewith as <u>Annexure-12 and 13</u> respectively.

8. That it is humbly submitted that being aggrieved by such illegal, arbitrary and discriminatory action of the Opposite Parties No.2 and 3 the petitioner has moved the Registrar, OUAT with a request to do the needful in the matter by allowing him the pay protection. On receipt of the series of representations of the petitioner, the Registrar, OUAT has requested the State Government to get his opinion in the matter, even though no such advice was required from Government, because OUAT is an autonomous body and it has to take its own decision. Furthermore the decision of the University is already there under Annexure-8 and 9, so no advice of State Govt. was required at all. Getting no alternative the petitioner has moved this Hon'ble Court in W.P.(C) No. 34221 of 2021 which

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

- 3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to sanction the benefits of pay protection pursuant to notification dated 26.09.2015 under Annexure-16 with arrear salary, annual increments and allowances as due and admissible to the post of Jr. Pathologist in accordance with law within a stipulated period.
- 4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-17 series and the same may be directed to be considered taking into consideration Annexures-13 & 14 Page 2 of 2 within a stipulated time.
- 5. Considering the limited grievance of the petitioner, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.3 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-17 series and pass appropriate order in accordance with law taking into consideration Annexures-13 & 14 within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.

9. That despite the order of the Hon'ble Court no action was taken by the authorities, for which the petitioner has filed CONTC

No. 1813 of 2022 which was disposed of on 31.03.2022 with a TRUE COPY ATTESTED

further direction to the university to comply the same within a period

of further two months. However on receipt of the order of this Hon'ble Court and the communication from the university the State Government in his letter no. 18660 dtd: 09.09.2022 clarified that since similarly situated persons have extended the benefits there is no reason to delay the matter in case of the present petitioner and as such direction was issued to the University to take decision in this regard at its end. Copy of the Government order dtd: 09.09.2022 is annexed herewith as Annexure-14.

- without application of mind and without taking note of its own decision under the Board of Governors' resolution dtd: 02.09.2015 and the consequential notification dtd: 26.09.2015, rejected the claim of the petitioner on the flimsy ground that the other similarly situated persons referred to in the earlier writ petition are not in the same footing as that of the petitioner and therefore rejected the claim of the petitioner. Copy of the order no. 21309 dtd: 30.12.2022 of the Registrar, OUAT is annexed herewith as Annexure-15.
- 11. That it is humbly submitted that the undisputed case of the petitioner with regard to claim of pay protection is that the Board of TRUE COPY ATTESTED

Management in its resolution dtd: 02.09.2015 have already resolved

to allow pay protection to the employees continue in KVKs on their either University the appointed/absorption Professor/Associate Professor in the constituency College or in the Research Unit. Here in this case the petitioner was given regular appointment in the research unit of OUAT and now continuing as a Junior Scientist (Pathology). Therefore he is entitled to the benefits of such notification of the OUAT dtd: 26.09.2015 under Annexure-9 and the pay protection ought to have been given to him. In the earlier writ petition he has referred to the orders granting pay protection to other similarly situated persons including this notification dtd: 26.09.2015. In fact those are the persons similarly placed as that of the petitioner. While not admitting but for the argument sake, if those persons are not similarly situated but granted the benefits of pay protection, the petitioner is to be granted the pay protection in view of the BOM Resolution dtd: 02.09.2015 and consequential notification dtd: 26.09.2015 which are still hold the field. The University cannot moved beyond these resolution and notification under Annexure-8 & 9 and moreover the provision of Rule-50 (1) and 51 of the OUAT Statute, 1966. For better appreciation of the case the relevant

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provisions of the OUAT Statue relating to pay protection is quoted as hereunder:

"50 (1) When a University employee holding a post in a substantive, temporary or officiating capacity for a period of not less than one year is promoted or appointed in a substantive Temporary or officiating capacity to another post carrying duties and responsibilities of greater importance than those attaching to the post held by him, his initial pay in the pay scale of pay of the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above the pay notionally arrived at by increasing his pay in respect of the lower post by one increment at the stage at which such pay has accrued.

Provided that this benefit shall not be admissible in the case of promotions or appointments of University employees above the rank of Assoc. Professors Readers but in their cases, the initial pay shall be determined under clause (2) or (3) as the case may be.

51. The past service, if any rendered in a post under the University on an identical pay scale of pay, of an employee whose initial pay is regulated under statute 50 may be taken into account for the purpose of fixation of initial pay on reappointment except when the past service has been interrupted by resignation on removal from University Service."

- 12. That from the aforesaid clear provisions of law and decision of the Apex Body of the OUAT i.e. the Board of Management and their notification dtd: 26.09.2015 and the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of pay protection and accordingly the order dtd: 30.12.2022 under Annexure-16 is unsustainable in law and liable to be quashed.
- 13. That for ends of justice and proper adjudication of the matter the petitioner has got no other speedy and efficacious remedy other

than invoking the extra- ordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court TRUE COPY ATTESTED

under Article 226 and 227 of the constitution of India.

# PRAYER

Under the above circumstances it is therefore humbly prayed that the Hon'ble Court be graciously pleased to quash the order dtd: 30.12.2022 of the Opposite Party No.2 under Annexure-15 and direct the Opposite Parties No.2 and 3 to grant the benefit of pay protection to the petitioner of his earlier post on joining the regular post as per the resolution of the Board of Management dtd: 02.09.2015 and the consequential notification dtd: 26.09.2015 under Annexure-8 and 9 respectively read with Rule-50 (1) and 51 of the OUAT Statute, 1966, within a stipulated period as deem fit and proper;

And further the Hon'ble Court be pleased to direct the Opposite Party No. 2 and 3 to calculate the differential arrears of such pay revision of the petitioner on granting pay protection and pay the same to him within a stipulated period as deem fit and proper;

And/or issue any other appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions as deem fit and proper in the fitness of the case;

And for this act of this kindness as in duty bound the petitioner shall ever pray.

# COUNTER TO THE FILED BY THE OPPOSITE PARTY NO. 2 & 3

I, Smt. Lopamudra Mohanty, aged about- 50 yeras years, W/O- Sri Biswaranjan Mohanty, at present working as Registrar, Odisha University of Agriculture & Technology do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows: -

- 1. That I am the Opp.Party no- 2 in the above noted case. I have gone through the contents of the writ petition filed by the petitioner and understood the contents thereof. I do herewith file my preliminary objection in the following manner.
- 2. That, the writ petition is not maintainable in the eye of law on the ground of limitation. Hence the writ petition is liable to be dismissed on the ground of limitation.
- 3. That, petitioner Dr. Manoj Kumar Rout, Junior Pathologist, OUAT in this writ petition has prayed lo

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quash the order No.21309/UAT, dt. 30.12.2022 under Annexure-15 of this writ petition passed by Registrar, OUAT ie. Opposite Party No-2. He has also prayed to direct the Opposite Parties No.2 & 3 to grant benefit of pay protection of his earlier post of Training Associate (Subsequently re-designated as SMS/Scientist) under KVK on joining in the regular post of Junior Pathologist as per resolution No.3942 dt. 02.09.2015 of BoM and OUAT Notification No21880/UAT, dt. 26.09.2015 (under Annexure-8 & 9 respectively) with all consequential service and financial benefits including differential arrears within the scheduled time.

4. That, in reply to para-1 to para-3 of the writ petition, it is submitted that the petitioner was initially appointed as Training Associate, Plant Protection at KVK,Boudh as per advertisement issued vide No.19396/UAT, dt. 16.07.2004 (Annex-1) and appointment order issued vide office order No.17750/UAT, dt. 16.06.2006 (Annex-2). As per the said appointment order, he joined on 23.06.2006 (F.N) on contractual basis with certain terms and Conditions in the scale of pay of Rs.8,000-275-13,500/- with usual DA & other allowances as admissible from time to time. As per SL.No.6 of the said appointment order,

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it has been clearly mentioned that "the past services if any (regular /temporary) shall not be counted and there shall be no continuity of the past services. So also the service during contractual period shall not be counted in the regular service"

The post of Training Associate was subsequently redesignated as SMS/ Scientist by OUAT. Similarly, the scale of pay of Rs.8.000-275-13.500/- was revised to Rs.15,600-39,100 + GP -6,000/- w.e.f. 23.06.2006 in 6th CPC.

- 5. That, in reply to para-4 of the writ petition, it is submitted that while the petitioner was continuing in KVK Kendrapara, he was selected for the post of Junior Pathologist (Asst. Professor equivalent) through proper selection procedure. After being selected, he was appointed vide office order No.29858/UAT, dt. 31.12.2015 (Annex-5) and joined as Junior Pathologist, AICRP on Jute Research Station, Kendrapara under OUAT on 13.01.2016 (FN) (Annex-7) on regular basis after being relieved from KVK, Kendrapara on 12.01.2016 (AN) (Annex-6).
- 6. That, in reply to para-5 of the writ petition. it is submitted that the OUAT is administrative authority for both the post of Training Associate (redesignated

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as SMSI Scientists) under KVK and also the post of Junior Pathologist (Asst. Professor/ Equivalent) under regular establishment of OUAT. But the KVK employee under OUAT are the contractual project staff till 100% funding of ICAR continues. The Service condition of KVK employees have been notified vide OUAT Notification No.19832/UAT, dt. 27.08.2014 after receipt of instruction from Govt. of Odisha vide letter No12043/Ag, dt. 18.07.2014 which is binding to all KVK employees under OUAT. The copy of notification dt. 27 08.2014 is enclosed as Annexure A/2. According to the above notification the service conditions of contractual staff in KVKs under OUAT are as follows:

- 1. The KVK employees are contractual staff and allowed regular scale of pay with annual increments and other benefits as per the ICAR guidelines till 100% funding of ICAR continues.
- 2. The KVK employees are not entitled to terminal benefits and their service is coterminous with the central project i.e. till the period 100% funds are made available by ICAR.
- 3. The State Government and OUAT will not shoulder any kind of liability pertaining to KVKs.

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4. The transfer of KVK employees will be within the KVKs only

It is a fact that after receipt of representation from some of the SMSs and Programme Coordinators in the KVKs for protection of pay in their new appointment in the regular post of Asst. Professor/equivalent or Associate Professor/ equivalent as the case may be, their cases were placed before the Board of Management through the memorandum (Annex-8). After approval of the BOM vide Resolution No.3942 dt.02.09.2015, a notification was issued vide No.21880/UAT, dt. 26.09.2015 (Annex 9) to allow the protection of pay of the SMS/ Programme Coordinator of KVKs who are to be appointed as Asst. Professor/equivalent and Associate Professor/ equivalent respectively in the regular post under OUAT.

7. That in reply to para-6 of the writ petition, it is submitted that the petitioner while working as SMS in KVK prior to his joining as Junior Pathologist on 13012016 in the regular establishment under OUAT, his scale of pay was Rs. 15,600-39, 100/ GP-6,000/- (pre-revised scale ). Accordingly, he was drawing the pay of Rs22,220/ as basic pay and GP-Rs.6,000/- as on 12.01.2016 i.e. on the date of relief from KVK to join in the regular post under OUAT. Since the post of Junior Pathologist was Carrying the scale of pay of

Odisha University of Agril & Technology

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Rs.15,600-39,100 + AGP Rs.6,000/- the petitioner was appointed in the above scale of pay and accordingly his pay was fixed at Rs.15,600 + AGP Rs.6,000/- on dt.13.01.2016 i.e. the date of his joining in the post of Junior Pathologist.

- 8. That in reply to para-7 of the writ petition, it is submitted that the petitioner in this paragraph has averred that the University authority has allowed the identical relief of pay protection to as many 13 persons in office order No.22880 dt. 08.10.2015 as per Annexure-12 of this writ petition. This allegation of the petitioner is misconceived. The fact is that the said 13 persons as per Annex-12 had been appointed as regular employees of OUAT. Subsequently, they were selected and appointed as contractual employees under KVKs. They were again re-absorbed to regular posts vide court orders and approval of the Board of Management, OUAT. The case of the petitioner is not similar with that of the 13 employees referred under Annexure-12. No similar employee like the petitioner has ever been given the protection of pay being absorbed into a regular post after serving as contractual employee in KVK.
- 9. That in reply to para-8 to para-13 of the writ petition, it is submitted that the proposal was sent to Govt. in Agriculture Department, Odisha vide

Odisha University of Agril & Technology

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University letter No. 15615/UAT, dt. 09.07. 2018 for consideration of protection of pay in favour of the petitioner alongwith 09 (nine) others as the basic pay of the post of Asst. Professor/ equivalent was Rs. 15,600 + AGP Rs.6.000/- and they were getting higher pay from the basic pay of Rs.15,600/- + AGP Rs.6,000/-. Since the proposal for protection of pay of the petitioner was not considered by the University, he filed case before the Hon'ble High Court of Odisha in W.P (C) No.34221 of 2021. The Hon'ble Court disposed of the case vide order dt. 17.11.2021 without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case. The order of the Hon'ble Court is on record, hence no comments. However, in obedience to the order dt. 17.11.2021 of the Hon'ble Court, the opposite party University has finally passed speaking order vide ofce order No.21309/UAT, dt.30.12.2022 (Annex-15) as per merit of the case.

It is further submitted that as stated in earlier paragraph that although the University has issued notification dt. 26.09.2015 for protection of pay of the SMS/ Programme Coordinator of KVKs under OUAT on their appointment in the regular posts under OUAT but due to the restrictions made vide notification dt. 27.08.2014 (Annexure-A/2), the University felt necessary to send the proposal to Govt. as because

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the notification dt. 2708,2014 has been issued on the basis of the guidelines received from Govt. vide their letter No. 120-:3/Ag, dt. 18.07 2014. So the opposite party University has not done any irregularities by sending the proposal to Govt. for consideration of protection of pay in favour of the petitioner along with similar situated employees in this category.

As regards implication of Statute 50 (1) & 51 of OUAT Statute, 1906 it is submitted that the petitioner was holding the post of SMS in KVK which was a contractual post and project based under OUAT. Subsequently he was posted in the post of Junior Pathologist which is a regular post under OUAT. So the provision enumerated under Statute 50 &51 of OUAT Statute, 1966 for protection of pay will not be applicable in favour of the petitioner. However, after receipt of instruction of Govt. vide letter No. 18660/A&FE DL 09.09.2022 the case of the petitioner was examined and appropriate decision was taken After due consideration of the case of the petitioner, the University authority passed office order No.21309/UAT, dt. 30.12 2022 (Annexure-15) and finally disposed tie grievance of the petitioner in obedience to order dt. 17.11.2021 passed by the Hon'ble Court in WP (C) No.34221 of 2021 filed by the petitioner earlier.

# Rejoinder to the Counter Affidavit filed by the Opp. Party No. 2 & 3:

I, Manoj Kumar Rout, aged about 49 years, son of Purna Chandra Rout, at present working as Junior Scientist (Pathology) in All India Coordinate Research Project (AICRP) on Seed Technology Research (STR), Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology (OUAT), Bhubaneswar, Dist-Khurda, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows:-

1. That I am the petitioner in this case. I have gone through the counter affidavit filed by the Opp. Party No.2 and 3 and have understood the contents made therein.

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- 2. That the petitioner in this case prays for quashing of the order dtd: 30.12.2022 of the Opp. Party No.2 under Annexure-15 and further prays for a direction to the Opp. Party No.2 and 3 to grant him the benefit of pay protection as per the resolution of the Board of Management dtd: 02.09.2015 and the consequential notification of the OUAT dtd: 26.09.2015 under Annexure-8 and 9 respectively with all differential arrear salary.
- 3. That it is humbly submitted that the Chapter-II of Article-4 of OUAT Statute 1989 provides the benefit of pay protection to the initial appointees in the OUAT subject to the condition the employee concern was working in State Government or Central Government or any College affiliated to any University or an Aided Institution or Statutory institution immediately before joining the University. Here in this case the petitioner was working in Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) established with the functioning of the Government of India through Indian Council of Agricultural Research was administered and managed by the OUAT. Therefore KVK is a Government of India Institution managed and administered by the OUAT. Therefore as per Article-4 of Chapter-II of the

OUAT Statute the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of pay protection on TRUE COPY ATTESTED

joining in the OUAT cadre as a Junior Pathologist, which is the research



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post. It is not out of place to mention here that in office order no. 6847/UAT dtd: 02.12.2009 of the Board of Management, OUAT was communicated, wherein and wherefrom it is clarified that the contractual employees of the KVK are to be governed under principle of OUAT Statute. Copy of the Chapter-II of the University Statute and order no.6847/UAT dtd: 02.12.2009 are annexed herewith as Annexure-16 and 17 respectively.

4. That it is not out of place to mention here that there were 13 regular employee of the OUAT in different lower grade (Research Assistant Cadre) having been selected and appointed in KVK against contractual post of Training Associate/re-designated as Subject Matter Specialist in a regular salary and in a higher pay scale. Since those employees holing a regular post, selected against contractual post in KVK which give rises to a litigation. However without prejudice to their claim the Opp. Party had allowed them to join in KVK in OUAT. All those 13 persons though have filed writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court as reflected in Annexure-12. All those cases were disposed in the premises that since the OUAT has taken care of the benefits of all those employees, the maters were remitted to the OUAT to take a decision in their favour. All these 13 persons while

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continuing in KVK in a higher grade have subsequently being selected

against another regular post in OUAT, which is higher than their earlier original post. Upon joining the OUAT against those new posts, all these 13 employees working in the KVK in the higher scale of pay were granted the benefit their pay protection on joining in OUAT. In other words, those 13 employees working in KVK on contractual basis on joining back in OUAT against a different cadre post than their original post have given the benefit of pay protection. In such view of the matter, the petitioner who is originally working in KVK on joining in OUAT against a sanctioned post is entitled to the pay protection in view of the orders under Annexure-8 and 9 and also for the reason that another 13 numbers similarly situated persons got such benefit. But unfortunately and surprisingly the authorities of the OUAT have disclosed half-truth in the matter and therefore stated that the petitioner is not similar to that of those 13 numbers. But the fact remains, the petitioner is quite similar and identical to those 13 persons and they have been given the benefit of pay protection, the petitioner is also entitled to the pay protection. Besides this in view of the order under Annexure-8 and 9 the Opp. Party-University cannot take a different stand now at this stage. Hence the statements made in the counter affidavit are strongly denied and disputed herewith to be true.

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- 5. That though a voluminous counter affidavit is filed by the Opp. Party No.2 and 3 but the petitioner failed to found substantial ground taken in the counter affidavit filed by the Opp. Party No.2 and 3. The Opp. Party No.2 and 3 failed to reply their own documents under Annexure-8 and 9 in any manner whatsoever. Therefore this writ petition is to be allowed on the principles of nontraverse.
- 6. That it is humbly submitted that instead of replying the core issue involved in this case as to whether an erstwhile employee of KVK on joining a teaching post or an equivalent post thereof in the OUAT is entitled to the benefit of any pay protection. This particular issue has already been answered in the documents under Annexure-8 and 9, which has also been accepted and approved by the State Government in order dtd: 09.09.2022 under Annexure-14. But surprisingly and unfortunately to deny the legitimate claim of the petitioner for the pay protection. To which he is legally entitled a novel stand has been taken in the counter affidavit that all these 13 employees were extended the identical relief by the OUAT are not similarly placed as that of the petitioner. With due respect it is humbly submitted that it is a blatant lie on the face of the record. All these

13 employees were continuing in the KVK and on joining against a new TRUE COPY ATTESTED

post under OUAT, they have been given their pay protection and they are

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in receipt of the salary having been allowed this pay protection. In such circumstances the statements made in this counter affidavit as against the petitioner designed to mislead this Hon'ble Court and to deprive the petitioner for his pay protection, which flows from the decision under Annexure-8 and 9.

- 7. That for the reason stated above the statements made in the counter affidavit filed by the Opp. Party No.2 and 3 which are not specifically replied are denied herewith to be true. However the petitioner reserves his right to file further affidavit, if required at the time of hearing of the case.
- 8. That the facts stated above are all true to the best of my knowledge and belief.





## Order No.

- **05.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
  - 2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
  - **3.** Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition *inter alia* challenging the order dtd.30.12.2022 so passed by Opposite Party No.2 under Annexure-15. Vide the said order, the claim of the Petitioner to get the benefit of pay protection in terms of the decision taken in the proceeding of the meeting of the Board of Management held on 02.09.2015 under Annexure-8 and consequential Notification issued by the University on 26.09.2015 under Annexure-9 has been rejected.
  - 4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that Petitioner was initially engaged as a Training Associate on








contractual basis, where he joined on 23.06.2006. The post of Training Associate was subsequently redesigned as Subject Matter Specialist vide communication issued on 05.06.2006 under Annexure-3.

- **4.1**. It is contended that Petitioner while continuing on contractual basis he was regularized w.e.f. 23.06.2006 vide order dtd. 28.12.2010 under Annexure-10.
- 4.2. It is contended that in terms of the decision taken by the Board of Management in its proceeding under Annexure-8 and consequential notification issued under Annexure-9, Petitioner became eligible to get the benefit of pay protection. But on the face of Annexures-8 & 9 when the benefit was not extended, Petitioner approached this Court in W.P.(C) No.34221 of 2021. Pursuant to the order passed by this Court Opposite Party No.2 vide the impugned order under Annxure-15 rejected the claim of the Petitioner to get the benefit of pay protection only on the ground that Petitioner is not a regular employee of the University and the decision taken under Annexure-8 so notified under Annexure-9 is only meant for regular employees.
  - **4.3**. Learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that since Petitioner vide order dtd.28.12.2010 under Annexure-10 was regularized w.e.f.23.06.2006 he will be treated as a regular employee of the University w.e.f. 23.06.2006 and accordingly his claim is squarely covered by the decision taken under Annexure-8 and the Notification issued under Annexure-9.





- **4.4.** It is accordingly contended that the impugned order is not sustainable in the eye of law and it requires interference of this Court.
- 5. Mr. M. Khuntia, learned counsel appearing for the University on the other hand made his submission basing on the stand taken in the counter so filed by Opposite Party Nos.2 and 3. It is the case of the Opposite Parties that since the Petitioner was engaged on contractual basis on 23.06.2006 the decision taken by the Board under Annexure-8 and consequential notification issued under Annexure-9, since is applicable for regular employees, Petitioner cannot get the benefit of pay protection and it has been rightly rejected vide order under Annexure-15.
- after going through the materials available on record, this Court finds that even though the Petitioner was engaged on contractual basis w.e.f. 23.06.2006 but vide order dtd.28.12.2010 under Annexure-10, he was regularized in his service from the said date. Therefore it is to be held that the Petitioner is a regular employee of the University w.e.f. 23.06.2006. Considering the submissions of Mr. Khuntia that the decision taken under Annexure-8 and the notification issued under Annexure-9 is applicable to regular employees since by the time Annexures-8 and 9 was issued, Petitioner was already regularized w.e.f. 23.06.2006, as per the considered view of this Court,






Petitioner is also eligible and entitled to get the benefit of pay protection in terms of Annexures-8 & 9.

- 7. Therefore, this Court is inclined to quash the office order dtd.30.12.2022 so passed by Opposite Party No.2 under Annexure-15. While quashing the same, this Court directs Opposite Party No.2 to extend the benefit of pay protection as due and admissible in favour of the Petitioner in terms of Annexures-8 & 9 with passing of an appropriate order in that regard within a period of two (2) months from the date of receipt of this order.
- 8. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.

Both in the impugned order under Annexure-15 of the Writ Petition so also in the counter affidavit filed therein, the stand of the present Appellants was that the Respondent No.1 was not a regular employee of the OUAT and thereby he is not entitled to the benefits flowing from the order under Annexure-8 and 9 of the writ petition. To clarify the facts vis-à-vis the law, the Respondent No.1 place the brief facts in the following paragraphs.

- The Respondent No.1 appointed as Training Associate (Plant Protection) in office order no. 17750 dtd: 16.06.2006 of the Registrar, OUAT by the order of the Vice Chancellor. However the Training Associates were re-designated as Subject Matter Specialist by the order of the authorities.
- (ii) The Respondent No.1 was however regularised as a regular Subject Matter Specialist in office order no. 63330 dtd: 28.12.2010 pursuant to University Notification No. 53602 dtd: 16.10.2010 from his initial date of joining i.e. 23.06.2006. Copy of the notification dtd: 16.10.2010 and order dtd: 28.12.2010 are annexed herewith as Annexure-A/1 & B/1 respectively.

- (iii) However vide notification no. 19832 dtd: 27.08.2014 OUAT superceeded its earlier notification dtd: 16.10.2010, meaning thereby the order of regularisation of the petitioner and others in order dtd: 16.10.2010 were affected. Copy of the order dtd: 27.08.2014 is annexed herewith as **Annexure-C/1**.
- (iv) Being aggrieved by such an order dtd: 27.08.2014 the Respondent No.1 has moved this Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) No. 18254 of 2014. However in office order no. 23335 dtd: 30.09.2014 the Registrar of the University by the order of the Vice Chancellor kept the Notification dtd: 27.08.2014 in abeyance. (vi) While the Respondent No.1 was so continuing as a regular of his writ petition, disposal employee recommendation of the Standing Selection Committee, he was appointed as Asst. - 4. That it is humbly submitted that considering all these vital aspects of the matter the Hon'ble Single Judge rightly held that the Respondent No.1 is entitled to the benefits flowing form the decision under Annexure-8 and 9 of the writ petition (Annexure-G/1 & H/1), as he was already regularised as a regular employee by a valid notification of the OUAT. Hence there is no illegality or infirmity.
- keeping the notification dtd: 27.08.2014 in abeyance was only revoked in office order no. 6354 dtd: 12.04.2016. With due respect such order dtd: 12.04.2016 in categorical terms provides that the notification dtd: 27.08.2014 will came into force with immediate effect i.e. from 12.04.2016. 

The Subject Matter Specialist of KVKs under OUAT, who appointed as Programme Coordinator in KVKs have submitted representation for their pay protection in the post of programme Coordinator as detailed below.

- 1. Some Subject Matter Specialists of KVKs under OUAT have been appointed as Programme Coordinator in the KVKs through selection Committee. 


