SYNOPSIS

Petitioner Institute was established in 2024 imparting D. Pharm. Courses and having fulfilled all the eligibility criteria the Directorate of Medical Education and Training, Odisha had granted NOC. The petitioner has subsequently applied before the Pharmacy Council of India for approval of the D. Pharm. Course for the academic year 2024 - 2025. In the meantime, Opp. Party No.3 issued a provisional consent of affiliation and as such the same shall be valid for a period of 1 year only. However, vide Letter dated 12/10/2024, Pharmacy Council of India rejected the application for want of Consent of Examining Authority. It is respectfully submitted that Petitioner in due compliance with the aforesaid time period, had submitted the necessary documents i.e. consent for affiliation from examining authority, however prior to any consideration of the requisite documents, Opp. Party No.2 had rejected his application, which is *dehors* in the eyes of the law.



MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH: -

1. The Petitioner College seeks to invoke the extraordinary and supervisory jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court as envisaged under Article 226 of the Constitution, challenging the highhanded and arbitrary action of the opposite parties, particularly Opp. Party No.2, rejected the petitioner's application for approval for the academic year 2024 -2025 without conducting any inspection and providing an opportunity for a hearing.

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2. That the Petitioner College is imparting D. Pharm. Courses and has had an immaculate



performance for the last two years. The petitioner college is functioning its office at Khurda. Petitioner is represented through its chairman, and the Petitioner's Office and place of work are situated within the territorial jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. The Opposite Parties are functionaries of the State Government and Union and are within the meaning of 'State' as enumerated under Article 12 of the Constitution of India. The cause of action for filing this writ application arises within the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.

3. That with huge aspirations and expectations, the Deponent constituted a college for imparting D. Pharm. Courses, and having fulfilled all the eligibility criteria the Directorate of Medical Education and Training, Odisha had granted NOC dated

10/07/2024 with an intake capacity of 40 seats for the academic session 2024-25.

Copies of NOC are annexed herewith as ANNEXURE-1.


- 4. That the Petitioner has subsequently applied before the Pharmacy Council of India for approval of the D. Pharm. Course for the academic year 2024 2025. The same aligned with the particulars mentioned in Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, of 1948. For better appraisal of the Hon'ble Court, the relevant section is quoted herein:
 - 12. Approved courses of study and examinations:-
 - (1) Any authority in a State ¹⁷][***] which conducts a course of study for pharmacists may apply to the Central Council for approval of the course, and the Central Council, if satisfied, after such enquiry as it



thinks fit to make, that the said course of study is in conformity with the Education Regulations, shall declare the said course of study to be an approved course of study for the purpose of admission to an approved examination for pharmacists.

- (2) Any authority in a State ¹⁷[***] which holds an examination in pharmacy may apply to the Central Council for approval of the examination, and the Central Council, if satisfied, after such enquiry as it thinks fit to make, that the said examination is in conformity with the Education Regulations, shall declare the said examination to be an approved examination for the purpose of qualifying for registration as a pharmacist under this Act.
- (3) Every authority in the State ¹⁷[***] which conducts an approved course of study or holds an approved examination shall furnish





such information as the Central Council may, from time to time, require as to the courses of study and training and examination to be undergone, as to the ages at which such courses of study and examination are required to be undergone and generally as to the requisites for such courses of study and examination.

Copy of the application form is annexed herewith as <u>ANNEXURE - 2.</u>

5. That it is relevant to note that since the consent for affiliation from the State Board of Pharmacy was pending approval from the competent authority, the Petitioner College instantaneously submitted an undertaking to that effect that he shall submit the consent for affiliation as well as NOC obtained from DMET as and when they are issued to him.

Copy of the Undertaking is annexed herewith as **ANNEXURE - 3.**



6. That in the meantime, Opp. Party No.3 issued a provisional consent of affiliation vide Letter No. 13666/OSBP Date 27/09/2024 which stipulated that the same shall be valid for a period of 1 year only.

Copy of Letter No. 13666/OSBP Date 27/09/2024 is annexed herewith as ANNEXURE - 4.

7. That immediately thereafter, Petitioner submitted the consent for affiliation to the Opp. Party No.2 vide Email dated 07/10/2024 requesting for inspection of the premise and further inquiry for approval of the course. However, no response was received in that regard.

8. That while things stood thus while checking the portal of the Pharmacy Council of India,

Petitioner came to know that his application



had been rejected on 12/10/2024 for want of Consent of Examining Authority, without providing any opportunity of hearing whatsoever.

Copy of the Rejection Letter dated 12/10/2024 is annexed herewith as ANNEXURE - 6

9. That furthermore, the Pharmacy Council of India, had time and again extended the time for compliance with statutory documents given the Order dated 10/04/2024 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Miscellaneous Application No.704 of 2024 in C.A.No.9048 of 2012. In pursuance of the said judgment, the time for compliance of statutory documents was extended up to 30/11/2024. Copy of the circulars is annexed herewith as

ANNEXURE - 7 SERIES.





- 10. That the action of the authorities has been arbitrary and in complete violation of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
- 11. That the Opp. Party without conducting any inspection nor providing any opportunity of hearing, has rejected the application of Petitioner unequivocally, therefore the same is liable to be set aside.
- 12. That the Act, 1948, envisions the power of the examining authority to conduct an inquiry before dispensing of with any application, either for course approval or examination approval, or both. It is a fact that Petitioner had submitted statutory documents for approval of the application and since the consent of affiliation of examining authority and NOC was pending approval, Petitioner had duly submitted an undertaking to that effect. Immediately, upon the receipt of the statutory documents, Petitioner had

Pure



submitted the same before Opp. Party No.2 for early requisition and inspection of the Institute.

However, the Opp. Party authorities without any prior intimation, or any notice of hearing to the Petitioner, had rejected the application of Petitioner, disregarding the due process of law.

- 13. That Petitioner in due compliance with the aforesaid time period, had submitted the necessary documents i.e. consent for affiliation from examining authority, however prior to any consideration of the requisite documents, Opp. Party No.2 had rejected his application, which is *de hors* in the eyes of law.
- 14. That it is not only the institute but also the several students, whose career have been put on stake owing to this rejection, and the same shall cause prejudice to them.



- 15. That it is a settled principle of law that when the Act mandates to do a particular thing in a particular manner it has to be done in that manner or no other manner at all.
- 16. That the issuance of an affiliation certificate can begin, only after the NOC is issued by the DMET authorities. In this case, the DMET authorities issued the NOC on 10/07/2024, and the petitioner college promptly submitted its application for affiliation. Following this, the Odisha State Board of Pharmacy, vide Letter dated 27/09/2024 issued consent for affiliation. Therefore, the delay in providing the affiliation document was not caused by the petitioner college, as the timeline was beyond its control.
- 17. That, since the matter involves the question of the career of innocent students finding no other alternative equally efficacious remedy



the petitioner has approached this Hon'ble Court for relief. Hence the Prayer:

PRAYER

It is therefore prayed that your Lordships may graciously be pleased to admit the writ petition, issue notice to the Opp. Parties particularly Opp. Party No.2 to show cause as to why;

the Order dated 12/10/2024 passed by the Pharmacy Council of India thereby rejecting the application for approval of course vide Annexure – 7 shall not be set aside;

And in the event, the Opp. Parties particularly Opp. Party No.2 fail to show cause or show insufficient case, Order dated 12/10/2024 passed by the Pharmacy Council of India thereby rejecting the application for approval of course vide Annexure – 6 shall be set aside;

And further be pleased to direct Opp. Parties particularly Opp. Party No.4 to allow fourteen



examination and allow to appear in the examination

And may pass any other order (s), direction(s),

relief(s) as deem fit and proper;

And for such act of kindness, the Petitioner shall as in duty bound ever pray.



With reference to the subject cited above, consequent upon Govt. approval obtained in OSWAS file No. HFW-MEII-NC-0004-2024, new NOC is issued in favour of Aahwaaan Institute of Health Science, At-Baghamara, Po-Bhandari Pokhari, Dist-Bhadrak, Pin-756122 for D-Pharm course (Intake Capacity-40) for the academic session (2024-25).

The NOC issued is subject to the following Conditions:-

1. The NOC is valid for one academic session only.

2. The institution shall seek affiliation from the concerned University /State Board and approval from the Pharmacy Council of India.

3. The institution shall not admit students without prior approval of PCI. No admission shall be made beyond the validity period of the NOC & the approved intake capacity.

4. No financial assistance/ grant in any case in any form will be given by the State Govt. The institution will have to bear all the recurring and non-

recurring expenditure for all time to came.

5. The State Govt. shall not give any grant for building etc. at any time. The building intended for educational occupancy will not be used for any hazardous occupancy.

6. The State Govt. shall not take over the school/college at the request of the

7. All the conditions of affiliation prescribed by the affiliating University or Board will have to met by the institution.



- 8. The college authorities will recruit the staff as per Government /University / PCI guideline and pay the salary to the staff in the pay scale prescribed by the Govt. from time to time.
- 9. Tuition fee and other charges will be as per the norms prescribed by Government/ affiliating University /Board.

- 1. The petitioner-College has approached this Court for issuance of directions to the respondent to consider the request of the petitioner-College for grant of approval for the Academic Year 2024-2025 for B.Pharm course.
- 2. The present petition arises out of peculiar facts, the Standard Inspection Form (for short 'the SIF) for conducting inspection and grant of approval was to be submitted by 30.01.2024. However, the petitioners got approval from the State Government on 30.07.2024, the University granted affiliation 20.09.2024.
- 3. The last date for considering the cases for approval was 31.10.2024 and for further compliances and approval, time was granted till 30.11.2024. The petitioner-College has also deposited fee to the tune of Rs.7,08,000/- (Rupees Seven lawysperbakhs Eight Thousand) plus Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) is able to the tune of registration.

- 4. Taking into consideration that there is still a period for considering the application for approval, we are inclined to allow the petition.
- 5. We therefore, direct the respondent's counsel to conduct the inspection and consider the application for grant of approval to the petitioner-College within a period of one week from today.
- 6. We clarify that the afroresaid order is passed in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case inasmuch as the approval from the State Government and affiliation by the University has itself come after the last date for submission of SIF.

Scheme for approval of D.Pharm course u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 and the Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma course in Pharmacy

The application for consideration of approval u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 shall be submitted by an authority to the Pharmacy Council of India on Council's portal only.

1. Eligibility Criteria:

The following authorities shall be eligible to apply **online** in the prescribed format named SIF (Standard Inspection Form) as per following details -

Authorities

- a) The Central Government / State Government / Union Territory administration.
- b) An autonomous body established by the Central or State Government for the purpose of pharmacy education.
- c) A University.
- d) A society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or corresponding Acts in States.
- e) A public religious or charitable trust registered under the Trust Act, 1882 (2 of 1882) or the Wakfs Act, 1954 (29 of 1954).

2. Qualifying Criteria:

The following conditions shall be fulfilled by an applicant.

- a) The applicant shall not start, conduct or increase in intake in D.Pharm course without the prior approval of the Pharmacy Council of India.
- b) D.Pharm course shall be conducted only in those institutions which are approved by PCI for D.Pharm course as provided under sub-section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
- c) The applicant shall provide necessary infrastructure facilities including teaching staff as prescribed by PCI
 - i) under Appendix-A of "The Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma course in Pharmacy" for starting of the course.
 - ii) Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
- d) Number of Students to be admitted in D.Pharm course:
 - At present the number of admissions to D.Pharm course are restricted to 60 only.

SCHEME FOR OBTAINING PERMISSION OF PHARMACY COUNCIL OF INDIA TO START PHARM.D. OR PHARM.D. AND PHARM.D. (POST BACCALUERATE) PROGRAMME

All applications under this scheme be submitted to the Secretary, Pharmacy Council of India, before the prescribed date mentioned in the schedule

1. Eligibility Criteria:

The following organizations shall be eligible to apply in the SIF for permission to start the Pharm.D., programme/s namely:

- a. A State Government / Union Territory
- b. A University
- c. A Registered Society under the Societies Registration Act

2. Qualifying Criteria:

Conditions to be fullfilled by person, institution, society or University to qualify to apply to PCI for permission to start Pharm.D. programme/s:

- a. The consent of Affiliation for the proposed Pharm.D. programme/s by the applicant from a University.
- b. No admission shall be made by the applicant to the proposed Pharm.D. programme/s without prior permission of the PCI.
- c. The applicant shall provide necessary additional infrastructural facilities as prescribed by the PCI under "Appendix B" of Pharm.D. regulations for the starting of Pharm.D. programme/s. Opening of the Pharm.D. programme/s in a hired or rented building shall not be permitted.
- d. The applicant should have been approved under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act 1948 for the conduct of B.Pharm course.
- e. The applicant shall provide 300 bed hospital facility as prescribed under regulation 2) of "Appendix B" of Pharm.D. regulations.



3. Form and Procedure:

- a. The applicant, subject to the fulfillment of above eligibility and qualifying criteria and also the requirements specified under the Pharm.D. regulations shall submit application in prescribed Standard Inspection Format (SIF) only, in triplicate to start the Pharm.D. programme/s to the Pharmacy Council of India.
- b. The SIF shall be submitted by the applicant either by Courier, Registered Post or in person to the Secretary, Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, along with a non-refundable application fee of Rs.2.00 lakhs in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "Pharmacy Council of India" payable at New Delhi. The said fee covers registration of application, technical scrutiny, contingent expenditure and two inspections.
 - Beyond two inspections, the normal inspection fee prescribed by council will apply as prescribed under para 4 of this scheme.
- c. The schedule for receipt of applications for the starting of Pharm.D programme and processing of applications by the Pharmacy Council of India is given in the para 6 of this scheme.
- d. The applications received by the Pharmacy Council of India will be registered in the council office for scrutiny. Registration of application will only signify the acceptance of the application for scrutiny. Incomplete applications will be rejected summarily without refund of application fee. The applicant may apply a fresh within the stipulated time alongwith the non-refundable application fee.
- e. The Council will scrutinize the application in the first instance in terms of the feasibility of starting the proposed programme/s at the said institution. While evaluating the application, the council may seek clarification or additional information from the applicant as deemed necessary and carry out physical inspection to verify the information supplied by the applicant.
- f. After examining the application and after conducting necessary physical inspections, the Council office shall submit to the Central Council factual report stating that:
 - i. The applicant fulfils the eligibility and qualifying criteria.
 - ii. The applicant has the necessary managerial and financial capabilities to establish the Pharm.D. programme.
 - iii. The applicant has a feasible and time bound programme for recruitment of faculty and staff as prescribed in the Pharm.D. regulations and that the necessary posts stand created.

- The applicant has appointed staff for 1st year of Pharm.D., & Pharm.D. (Post bacculearte) programme.
- v. The applicant has not admitted students without prior permission of PCI CLEAR
- vi. Deficiencies of any kind shall be pointed out indicating whether these are streets.

- g. The Central Council may then permit/approve/reject the application for conduct of Pharm.D., Programme/s and accordingly issue letter in a time bound manner specifying annual targets to be achieved by the applicant during the following years, if permission/approval is granted.
- h. The recommendation of the Central Council shall be final.
- i. The permission to establish the Pharm.D., Programme will be given initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of the achievements of annual targets. It is the responsibility of the institution to apply to the Pharmacy Council of India for purpose of renewal six month prior to the expiry of the initial permission. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of all infrastructural facilities and staff requirements prescribed in the Pharm.D. regulation are completed and approval under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act 1948 for the conduct of Pharm.D programme is granted to the institution.


