

RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:-

- That the aforesaid anticipatory bail petition is pending before this Hon'ble Court in which next date of hearing is fixed for dated 08.09.2025
- 2. That it is respectfully submitted that the present FIR No. 626 dated 27.11.2024 which was initially registered under Section 115(2), 191(3), 190) 117(1), 60, 76, 351(2) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita & 3 (1) (5) SC/ST Act lodged at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad. That during the pendency of present petition, complainant have moved application for alteration of charge which was allowed in 11.08.2025 and subsequently Section 117(4) of the BNS

- and Section 3(2)(VA) of the SC/ST Act was added instead of 117(1) BNS and 3 (1) (5) SC/ST Act in the present FIR
